## TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR STADIO RADIO BURSARIES

### 1.1 DEFINITIONS

- a. The following definitions are applicable in the Terms and Conditions for the STADIO Radio Bursaries

<b>Beneficiary</b>	Successful recipient of the STADIO Radio Bursary
<b>DHET</b>	The Department of Higher Education and Training
<b>Fee Schedule</b>	The schedule, attached to the Registration Agreement, setting out the fees in respect of each programme offered by STADIO, including, inter alia, details of the tuition fee, registration fee and payment options available
<b>Institution</b>	STADIO Proprietary Limited, herein referred to as STADIO
<b>Distance Learning Radio Bursary</b>	A sum of money allocated by STADIO to a Beneficiary, the sum of which is equal to the beneficiary's first-year tuition fee for a distance learning programme. Beneficiaries will not receive the funds directly, but the money will be allocated to the STADIO institutional account of the Beneficiary on successful registration.
<b>Contact Learning Radio Bursary</b>	A sum of money allocated by STADIO to a Beneficiary, the sum of which is equal to the beneficiary's first-year tuition fee for a contact learning programme. Beneficiaries will not receive the funds directly, but the money will be allocated to the STADIO institutional account of the Beneficiary on successful registration.
<b>Radio Bursary</b>	Refers to either the Distance Learning Radio Bursary or the Contact Learning Radio Bursary in accordance with which bursary was awarded to the Beneficiary
<b>Programme</b>	Any undergraduate programme as offered by the Institution, offered in either distance or contact modes of learning
<b>Registration Agreement</b>	The legal contract between the Institution and the student which is a binding document
<b>Registration fee</b>	Amount payable by the Beneficiary on successful registration in accordance with the Fee Schedule
<b>STADIO</b>	STADIO Proprietary Limited, a registered private higher education institution with the Department of Higher Education and Training under the Higher Education Act, 1997, with registration certificate number 2008/HE007/004, incorporating the former brands of LISOF, Southern Business School, Prestige Academy and Embury
<b>Tuition fee</b>	The cost stipulated in the Fee Schedule relating to the qualification for which the student has registered

## 2.1 AWARD

- a. The Host Radio Station will select the Beneficiary to which to award the Distance Learning Radio Bursary and the Contact Learning Radio Bursary according to the terms and conditions agreed with the Host Radio Station.
- b. The Beneficiary must be a new student and cannot be a student that is already registered with STADIO.
- c. The Radio Bursary will cover the Beneficiary's tuition fee for the Beneficiary's first year of tuition in 2022 only, excluding the registration fee and any other ancillary fees. For the avoidance of doubt, the Beneficiary will have to cover the Registration fees per semester, including ancillary fees, text books and the like.
- d. The Radio Bursary is available to cover the tuition fees of the first year of the Beneficiary's undergraduate programme in 2022 and is not available for subsequent years of study or for any postgraduate programmes.
- e. The Radio Bursary cannot be transferred or exchanged for cash or any other compensation and will be used only for the purposes of covering the Beneficiary's first year tuition fees.

## 3.1 PROGRAMME

- a. The Beneficiary of the Distance Learning Radio Bursary may select to register for any programme offered by the Institution in distance mode of learning, as available according to the Institution's DHET certificate.
- b. The Beneficiary of the Contact Learning Radio Bursary may select to register for any programme offered by the Institution in contact mode of learning, as available according to the Institution's DHET certificate.
- c. In order for the Beneficiary to enrol in the selected programme, the Beneficiary must agree to the terms and conditions of enrolment.
- d. The Beneficiary will then be required to register for the specific programme selected and must complete and sign the Registration Agreement.
- e. The Beneficiary is entitled to transfer his/her enrolment from one STADIO programme to another, at the same campus, and in the same academic year subject to meeting the admission criteria of the other programme, and subject to following the administrative processes and timelines for registration prescribed by STADIO, and subject to availability in the other STADIO programme.
- f. Should the Beneficiary transfer his/her enrolment in accordance with e. above, the Beneficiary is entitled to transfer to another programme of equal or similar value.
- g. The Beneficiary must meet all admission criteria for the programme as prescribed by STADIO, in order to enrol and be registered for the selected programme. Should the Beneficiary not meet the minimum admission criteria, a representative from STADIO will be in contact with the Beneficiary to ascertain what programme the Beneficiary does qualify for.
- h. Should the Beneficiary not meet the admission criteria for any programmes as offered by STADIO, the Beneficiary will forfeit the Radio Bursary awarded to the Beneficiary, with no further compensation.

## 4.1 DISCLAIMER

- a. **STADIO** is responsible for providing the Beneficiary with a Radio Bursary in accordance with these terms and conditions and does not warrant the success in the programme selected of the Beneficiary.

## 5.1 FEES

- a. The Radio Bursary will cover the Beneficiaries first-year tuition fees for 2021 only.
- b. The Beneficiary will be obligated to settle any Registration fee or ancillary fees, including text book fees as applicable. Further details are provided in the Fee Schedules of the Institution.
- c. The Beneficiary will not receive the funds directly, instead the money will be allocated to the institutional account of the Beneficiary on successful registration.

## 6.1 CORRECT INFORMATION

- a. The Beneficiary warrants that they qualify to study at a higher education institution with entry with a minimum of an NQF 5 level.
- b. The Beneficiary warrants that all information provided to the Host Radio Station is true and correct in every respect and that any false information provided may lead to the Radio Bursary being null and void.
- c. The Beneficiary warrants that all information provided to STADIO is true and correct in every respect and that any false information provided may lead to the termination of the Radio Bursary at any time and that STADIO may inform others, including Government agencies, of this false information.
- d. In the event of the Beneficiary's Radio Bursary being terminated as a result of false information, the Beneficiary will not be entitled to a refund of any fees paid, nor will the Beneficiary be entitled to any compensation in lieu of the Radio Bursary awarded.

## 7.1 PERSONAL INFORMATION

- a. To administer the Radio Bursary, it is necessary for STADIO to process personal information of the Beneficiary, including but not necessarily limited to: Identifying information, biometric information, contact information (including address), demographic details, academic details regarding prior learning, employment details where applicable and in some cases, supporting documentation.
- b. STADIO respects the right to privacy and will only process the Beneficiary's personal information for the following purposes:
  - i. delivering academic services (including but not limited to: administering student and prospective student admissions, enrolment, registration, education, engagement, and validation of qualifications);
  - ii. providing information on additional academic service offerings;
  - iii. fee payment or collection;
  - iv. any additional purposes to which you consent; and
  - v. as otherwise required by law.
- c. By accepting these term and conditions, the Beneficiary gives consent that STADIO and its approved representatives may:
  - i. process the Beneficiary's personal information for the purposes stated above as well as any other directly related purposes, including cloud storage of your information outside RSA;
  - ii. obtain information concerning your academic certificate and/or transcript from any school, university or other educational institution previously attended and use it to validate your qualifications;

- iii. share the Beneficiary's personal information with qualification verification agencies, who in turn may enter your qualification information into the National Learners Register Database;
  - iv. share the Beneficiary's personal information with third party service providers engaged by STADIO for the purposes listed above;
  - v. contact the Beneficiary with information about additional academic service offerings with the option to opt out of further similar correspondence;
  - vi. process, as confidential information, any health information provided by the Beneficiary for the purpose of accommodating disability or sick leave;
  - vii. process the Beneficiary's personal information as needed to meet security requirements, and the requirements of government, professional bodies and other regulatory authorities; and
  - viii. in the event of any reorganization, merger, or acquisition of STADIO, the Beneficiary's personal information may be transferred as part of the transaction to the acquirer, whether inside or outside RSA.
- d. Beneficiary – By accepting these terms and conditions, the Beneficiary also makes the following declaration:
- i. I hereby certify that I will provide information that is true, correct and complete. I understand that false or incomplete information will invalidate this Radio Bursary and this application.
