SUBJECT: PPSA Notes Pretoria High Court Ruling

The Public Protector South Africa (PPSA) has noted the ruling of the Pretoria High Court delivered on Thursday, 18 April 2024, removing the matter of *Mkhwebane v Office of the Public Protector & Others* from the roll, and directing the parties to approach the Deputy Judge President for the case management of the application so that the application of Adv. Busisiwe Mkhwebane can be heard as a special motion. This is what the PPSA proposed to the Court, and it is notable that the Court, in fact, granted same.

The PPSA will not entertain any unfounded accusations. The merits of the main application are still the subject of ongoing litigation, thus, no further comment will be made regarding this matter at this time.
